AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 738

1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 14, by striking out "By January 1,
2 2014" and inserting

3 Within nine months after the effective date of this
4 section

5 Amend Bill, page 2, line 17, by striking out "biennially" and
6 inserting

7 triennially

8 Amend Bill, page 3, line 2, by inserting after "projects,"
9 along with accompanying data, that is based upon the length and
10 cost of the required extensions and the numbers of customers
11 affected for each potential project

12 Amend Bill, page 3, line 5, by striking out "will be
13 utilized" and inserting

14 is available

15 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 10 through 12, by striking out "of
16 any agreement a prospective customer" in line 10 and all of
17 lines 11 and 12 and inserting

18 that will be used to enter into an agreement with a
19 prospective customer in order to obtain access to an
20 expansion and extension project.

21 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 26 and 27

22 (d) Confidentiality.--At the request of the natural gas
23 distribution utility, the commission shall maintain
24 confidentiality of specific information deemed to be
25 proprietary.

26 Amend Bill, page 4, lines 9 and 10, by striking out "The
27 period of time, which shall not be less than ten years" and

1 inserting

2 A reasonable period of time based on the customer contribution,
3 which shall not be less than ten years or a lesser period of
4 time by mutual agreement between the prospective customer and
5 the natural gas utility distribution utility

6 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 18 and 19

7 (6) Support for the economic test used to determine the
8 customer contribution for line extensions and comparisons
9 with other economic tests, such as a net revenue screen or
10 net present value method.

11 Amend Bill, page 5, line 10, by inserting after "service"

12 and the manner in which a customer will be charged for
13 expansion

14 Amend Bill, page 5, lines 24 and 25, by striking out "the

15 outreach program by the utility to expand its customer class"

16 and inserting

17 how the outreach program could expand its customer class,
18 how geographic issues will be evaluated

19 Amend Bill, page 6, line 5, by inserting after "criteria"

20 , taking into consideration the saturation and other
21 characteristics of each natural gas distribution utility
