AN ACT

1 2	Relating to the satisfaction of oil and gas leases; and providing for certain forms and damages.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Short title.
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Oil and Gas
7	Lease Satisfaction Act.
8	Section 2. Definitions.
9	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
10	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:
12	"Lessee." A person who has obtained the right to explore,
13	drill, stimulate, produce, market and sell the oil, gas and
14	natural gas liquids, or portion of the oil, gas and natural gas
15	liquids, by means of a properly executed lease.
16	"Lessor." An owner of the oil and gas in place who controls
17	the oil and gas rights and has executed a lease.

1 Section 3. Satisfaction, methods and indexing.

2

(a) Methods of satisfying oil and gas leases.--

3 (1) Oil and gas leases shall be satisfied by
4 satisfaction documents as described in sections 5 and 6 by
5 the recording officer of the applicable county. A
6 satisfaction document shall be accompanied by information
7 sufficient to validate the original oil and gas lease
8 recording information in the public record, which shall
9 include the following:

10

(i) The original oil and gas lease.

11 (ii) A records fee established by the recording12 officer.

(2) A recording officer shall give notice of the
recording validation procedure. The notice shall be entitled
"Notice by (recording officer) to Adopt Recording Information
Validation Procedure under the Oil and Gas Lease Satisfaction
Act," and shall state any additional fees to be charged and
shall be advertised in the county recorder's yearly fee
schedule or fee bill, whichever is applicable.

20 (b) Indexing.--The recording officer shall properly index 21 all satisfaction documents against the name of the lessee or 22 last assignee as each is indicated in the satisfaction document 23 and shall indicate the recording of each satisfaction document 24 in the oil and gas lease record.

(c) Liability of recording officer.--Nothing in this act shall impose liability on any recording officer or any political subdivision for a mistake, error or inaccuracy found in a satisfaction document which was presented for recording by a person or entity and which was recorded by the recording officer or political subdivision.

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1	Section 4. Requirement and effect of satisfaction document.
2	Every lessee shall, within 30 days after expiration,
3	termination or forfeiture of the oil and gas lease, present for
4	recording in the office where the oil and gas lease is recorded
5	a duly executed satisfaction document in substantially the form
6	set out in section 5 and acknowledged as provided by law. The
7	satisfaction document shall thereafter discharge, defeat and
8	release a lessee's interests in the lease upon recording.
9	Section 5. Form of satisfaction document.
10	A lessee, whether an individual or legal entity, shall
11	satisfy oil and gas leases by a satisfaction document in
12	substantially the following form:

30	undersigned authorizes and empowers the recording officer

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of the county to enter this satisfaction document and to cause the oil and gas lease to be satisfied of record. Witness the due execution of this document with the intent to be legally bound. (signature(s) of individual lessee(s) or representative(s) of legal entity) (acknowledgment)

7 Section 6. Notice to satisfy and damages for failure to8 satisfy.

9 (a) Notice.--After the time set forth in section 4, the 10 lessor may send a notice to the lessee to present for recording 11 a satisfaction document to avoid damages.

(b) Delivery.--The satisfaction notice to satisfy shall be sent to the lessee by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested. The satisfaction notice shall be sent to the lessee at the lessee's address designated in the oil and gas lease unless the person issuing the notice has actually received from the lessee another name or address to which requests for satisfactions are to be sent.

19 (c) Form.--The notice to satisfy shall be in substantially20 the following form:

The party issuing this notice believes that the terms of the oil and gas lease described below have expired, terminated, forfeited or received full satisfaction. The

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1 concerning the oil and gas lease or provide a 2 satisfactory reason why the oil and gas lease should not 3 be satisfied to the party issuing this notice. If you do not comply with this notice, you may be liable for 4 5 penalties and costs in accordance with this act or the 6 party issuing this notice may be able to satisfy the oil 7 and gas lease without your consent. 8 Name of lessor: 9 Name of lessee: 10 Name of last assignee: 11 Date of oil and gas lease: 12 Recorded in County, Pennsylvania, in Book 13 Page /instrument number. 14 Brief description of the location covered by oil and gas 15 lease: Lease number (if known): 16 17 Name of party presenting this notice: 18 Address of party presenting this notice: 19 Telephone number of party presenting this notice: 20 (d) Penalty for failure to satisfy .--21 If, within 60 days of the lessee's receipt of the (1)22 first written request by the lessor for the satisfaction 23 document, delivered and in substantially the form described 24 in this section, the lessee fails to present for recording to 25 the office where the oil and gas lease was recorded a 26 satisfaction document as described in section 5 or the oil 27 and gas lease is not otherwise satisfied, the lessee may 28 initiate an appropriate court action to compel satisfaction 29 of the lease, unless a satisfactory reason was provided as to why the oil and gas lease shall not be satisfied. 30

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1 (2) In a successful action to compel satisfaction of the 2 lease, the lessee shall reimburse the lessor for costs of the 3 action, including the lessor's reasonable attorney fees.

4 (3) An action under this section shall be the exclusive
5 remedy for damages for failure of a lessee to issue and
6 present for recording a satisfaction document.

7 (4) The delivery of a second or subsequent written
8 request by the lessor for a satisfaction document shall not
9 give rise to an additional cause of action under this
10 section.

11 Section 7. Other rules or laws not affected.

12 This act shall not affect nor impair any other act or any 13 rule of civil procedure promulgated by the Pennsylvania Supreme 14 Court, which provides for the satisfaction or discharge of an 15 oil and gas lease by order or decree of any court upon payment 16 of an applicable fee. The recording officer shall accept for recording a copy of the order or decree certified by the 17 prothonotary and shall index and indicate the same in the record 18 19 as is provided in this act for a satisfaction document. Except 20 as provided in section 3(a), this act shall not affect or impair any other act providing for fees for the recording of the 21 documents and instruments provided for in this act. 22

23 Section 8. Prior instruments.

Written satisfaction or intended satisfaction given prior to the date of this act with respect to any oil and gas lease on real property situate in this Commonwealth shall be deemed good, valid and effective in law for the purposes therein recited. Section 9. Applicability.

29 This act shall apply to every oil and gas lease on real 30 property in this Commonwealth which has not been satisfied prior

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1 to the effective date of this section and regardless of whether 2 the oil and gas lease was executed before the effective date of 3 this section.

- 4 Section 10. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
