## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of October 22, 2014 (P.L.2873, No.175),
- 2 entitled "An act requiring the Department of Environmental
- 3 Protection to receive approval from the General Assembly for
- a State plan to regulate carbon dioxide emissions for
- 5 existing stationary sources prior to submitting the State
- 6 plan to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for
- approval," further providing for submission of State plan.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of October 22, 2014
- 11 (P.L.2873, No.175), known as the Pennsylvania Greenhouse Gas
- 12 Regulation Implementation Act, is amended to read:
- 13 Section 4. Submission of the State plan.
- 14 (a) Submission for approval to the General Assembly.--No
- 15 less than [100] 180 calendar days prior to the department
- 16 submitting the State plan to the EPA for approval, the
- 17 department shall transmit the plan to the General Assembly for
- 18 approval.
- 19 (b) Consideration by General Assembly. -- Upon transmission

- 1 under subsection (a), the State plan shall be:
- 2 (1) proposed as a resolution in each chamber;
- 3 (2) placed on the calendar of each chamber for the next 4 legislative day following transmission; and
- 5 (3) considered by each chamber within 20 <u>legislative</u> 6 days after [transmission] <u>placement under paragraph (2)</u>.
- 7 (c) Approval.--If each chamber of the General Assembly
- 8 adopts the resolution under subsection (b), the department may
- 9 submit the State plan to the EPA for consideration.
- 10 (d) Disapproval.--If either chamber of the General Assembly
- 11 disapproves the resolution under subsection (b), the department
- 12 may not submit the State plan to the EPA for consideration. The
- 13 department shall do all of the following:
- 14 (1) Determine the reasons for disapproval and modify the
- 15 State plan.
- 16 (2) Cause the State plan to be resubmitted to the
- General Assembly utilizing the process delineated under
- subsection (b) within 60 <u>calendar</u> days of the disapproval.
- 19 (3) If necessary, request an extension of time from the
- 20 EPA by submitting an initial State plan by [June 30, 2016]
- 21 the initial State plan submission deadline under 40 CFR
- 22 60.5760 (relating to What are the timing requirements for
- 23 <u>submitting my plan?)</u>, that meets the minimum requirements for
- an initial State plan, as specified in the plan guidelines
- 25 published by the EPA. The department shall transmit the
- following message with its submittal under this paragraph:
- 27 Be advised that the State plan submitted by the
- Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection has
- not yet met the requirements of the Pennsylvania
- 30 Greenhouse Gas Regulation Implementation Act requiring

1 affirmative approval of the General Assembly. It is the intention of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to submit a 2 3 State plan which conforms to this rulemaking. Under section 111(d) of the Clean Air Act, states must be given 4 5 an opportunity to meet Federal environmental standards set forth by the Environmental Protection Agency. The 6 7 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby invokes the authority 8 provided to it under section 111(d) of the Clean Air Act, 9 and, in accordance with the Pennsylvania Greenhouse Gas 10 Implementation Act, will be making a further filing with 11 the agency.

- (e) Default approval.--If no vote is taken by either chamber of the General Assembly to approve or disapprove the resolution under subsection (b) [before the June 15, 2016, deadline] at least 14 calendar days prior to the final State plan submission deadline under 40 CFR 60.5760, the State plan shall be deemed approved and shall be submitted to the EPA immediately.
- 18 (f) Default approval after time to cure. -- If either chamber
  19 of the General Assembly fails to approve a resubmitted plan
  20 under subsection (d)(2), within 60 <u>calendar</u> days of the
  21 [extension] <u>final State plan submission extension deadline under</u>
  22 40 CFR 60.5760, the resubmitted plan shall be deemed approved.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
