Established in 1980


Pennsylvania joined in 1985



Bay Watershed

- Half of PA land area
- 30% of the PA population
- 57% of PA farms in watershed
 Pennsylvania
- 35% of the Bay watershed
- Susquehanna provides 50% of the Bay's freshwater; 43% of the nitrogen




Water Quality: Nutrients & Sediments







PA Impaired Waters




